**Subject: Implementation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme on Blue Revolution: Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries during the financial year 2018-19 - Administrative Approval - regarding**

Sir,

In continuation of this Department's Administrative Approval No. 27035-19/2015-Fy(IV) dated 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2018 on the above subject, I am directed to convey the Administrative Approval of Government of India for implementation/continuation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme(CSS) on "**Blue Revolution: Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries**" at an outlay of **Rs.732.45 crore (Rupees : Seven hundred thirty two crore forty five lakh only)** during the financial year 2018-19 with the following components:

- (i) National Fisheries Development Board and its activities(NFDB),
- (ii) Strengthening of Database & Geographical Information System of the Fisheries Sector,
- (iii) Monitoring, Control and Surveillance and other need-based Interventions (MCS),
- (iv) Institutional Arrangement for Fisheries Sector,
- (v) Development of Inland Fisheries and Aquaculture,
- (vi) Development of Marine Fisheries, Infrastructure and Post Harvest Operations,
- (vii) National Scheme of Welfare of Fishermen

2. The details of funding patterns, mode of submission of proposals, evaluation and approval of proposals, fund released and monitoring mechanisms etc. as stipulated in this Department's earlier Administrative Approval No 27035-19/2015-Fy(IV) dated 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2018 of the CSS remain unchanged till further order in this regard. This administrative approval has been uploaded in the Department's website <http://www.dahd.nic.in>.

3. The detailed implementation guidelines, cost norms, unit costs and associated terms and conditions etc. in respect of all the components and sub-components of the CSS shall be as initially notified vide this Department's approval No.27035-19/2015-Fy(IV)-Vol.II dated 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2016 and as revised and amendments issued from time-to-time. The funding pattern of the CSS shall continue to be as per para-3 and para-4 of this Department's Administrative approval No 27035-19/2015-Fy(IV) dated 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2018 till further order in this regard.

5. State Governments/UT Administrations/NFDB are requested to formulate specific action plan, strategy and roadmap for development and management of fisheries in their respective States/UTs in accordance of the provision of the CSS to achieve the set targets of the CSS.

6. The State Governments/UTs are requested to sensitize all the concerned fisheries stakeholders such as State agencies/organisations, corporations, federations, fishers, fish farmers, cooperatives, private entrepreneurs, individual beneficiaries, weaker sections like Scheduled Castes (SCs), Scheduled Tribes (STs), women and their co-operatives etc. about the provisions of the CSS and to avail the benefits of the CSS.

7. The State Governments/UTs are also requested to submit self contained project proposals in respect of the desired component in accordance with the provisions of the CSS as stipulated in the Department Administrative Approval No. 27035-19/2015-Fy(IV) dated 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2018 and in accordance with the Guidelines of the CSS as notified vide administrative order No.27035-19/2015-Fy(IV)-Vol.II dated 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2016 (as mentioned in para 3 and para-4 above). Availability of adequate matching budgetary provision in State

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budget(wherever necessary), necessary clearances and land wherever necessary, need to be specifically indicated in the proposals.

8. This administrative approval is also subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (a) Provisions of General Financial Rules, 2017 shall be applicable henceforth.
- (b) Release of funds shall be as per Cash Management System guidelines issued by Budget Division, Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance vide OM No.15(39)-B(R)/2016, dated 21.8.2017.
- (c) The flow of funds is to be ensured through PFMS / DBT platforms.
- (d) The UCs shall be submitted only through PFMS in accordance with guidelines issued in this regard by the Chief Controller of Accounts, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare.

9. No request for *ex-post facto* approval of any proposal would be entertained.

10. This issues with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division Dy. No. 7624/AS&FA dated 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2018 and approval of the Competent Authority.
