Subject:- Continuation of Centrally Sponsored Scheme on Development of Marine Fisheries, Infrastructure and Post Harvest Operations as Central Sector Scheme during the financial year 2015-16 - Administrative Approval - regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to convey administrative approval of Government of India for continuation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme on Development of Marine Fisheries, Infrastructure and Post Harvest Operations as Central Sector Scheme during the financial year 2015-16 at a total Central outlay of ₹7000 lakh (Rupees seventy crore only) with the following components:

1. Development of Marine Fisheries

- (a) Motorisation of Traditional Craft
- (b) Safety of Fishermen at Sea
- (c) Fishermen Development Rebate on HSD Oil
- (d) Introduction of Intermediate Craft of Improved Design including proto-type study of new intermediate vessel design.
- (e) Establishment and operation of Vessel Monitoring System
- (f) Promoting fuel efficient and environment friendly fishing practices
- (g) Management of Marine Fisheries

2. Development of Infrastructure and Post Harvest Operations

- (i) Establishment of Fishing Harbours and Fish Landing Centres
- (ii) Strengthening of Post Harvest Infrastructure
- (iii) Assistance for maintenance dredging of fishing harbours and fish landing centres.

3. Taking up innovative activities.

2. Component-wise details of the scheme are appended as <u>Annexure-I</u> and are subject to 40% ceiling on capital cost of infrastructure project in general areas and 55% in north-eastern and hilly areas till further orders.

- 3. State Governments, Union Territories, Port Trusts and other concerned agencies are requested to send their proposals in respect of various components as outlined in component-wise details of scheme(Annexure-I), duly completed in all respect. The States/UTs are also requested to sensitize all concerned such as Corporations, Federations, Marketing Boards, Fishermen Cooperative Societies/Organizations, PRIs, NGOs, SHGs and Pvt. Entrepreneurs about the provisions of the scheme for availing its benefits. Availability of adequate budgetary provision in State budget, necessary clearances and land wherever necessary should be specifically indicated in the proposals. No request for *ex-post facto* approval of any proposal would be entertained.
- 4. It is suggested that the State Governments, Union Territories, Port Trusts and other concerned agencies may accord high priorities to the important proposals such as (i) proposals relating to management of marine fisheries to ensure sustainability of marine fisheries, (ii) creation of infrastructure facilities such as fishing harbours and fish landing centres, (iii) creation of post harvest infrastructures to develop cold chain for fisheries sector to reduce the post harvest losses, (iv) supply of safety kits to needy fishermen to ensure their safety at sea and (v) motorization of traditional craft. Preference may be accorded to the proposals to accrue direct benefits to Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe(ST) categories. It may be ensured that under the scheme, SCSP shall have only direct benefits to the individual SCs and general infrastructure for overall fishery activities shall not be calculated under Major Head 3601(SCSP).
- 5. This issues with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division vide their Dy No.300/AS&FA/2015 dated 30th June, 2015 and approval of the competent authority in this Department.
