Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the captioned subject and to inform that this Department is implementing a flagship scheme the "Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana(PMMSY) - A scheme to bring about Blue Revolution through sustainable and responsible development of fisheries sector in India" at a total investment of Rs. 20050 crores for a period of 5(five) years from FY 2020-21 to FY 2024-25 in all the States and Union Territories(UTs). Administrative Approval and detailed Operational Guidelines of the PMMSY have been issued on 12.6.2020 and on 24th June, 2020 respectively. The Operational Guidelines are also uploaded in this Department's website (http://www.dof.gov.in).

- 2. It is further informed that the PMMSY *inter-alia* provides that 2.5% of the annual budgetary allocation under PMMSY (central share) would be earmarked for meeting the administrative expenses for implementation, monitoring, evaluation and review of PMMSY (both Central Sector and Centrally Sponsored Scheme components) by the Department of Fisheries(DoF), National fisheries Development Board(NFDB) and the End Implementing Agencies (EIAs). Besides, the PMMSY also provides that DoF on the recommendations of Central Apex Committee (CAC) of PMMSY will earmark the extent of funds under administrative expenses that would be released to NFDB & EIAs. Further, the PMMSY also provides that DoF would be competent to decide on the modalities and guidelines including cost norms for incurring expenditure under Administrative expenses. This also includes the modalities, guidelines and cost norms for establishing and operating the Project Appraisal Committee (PAC) and Programme Monitoring Unit (PMU) in NFDB, CSC, CAC and Project Monitoring and Evaluation Unit (PMEU) in the DoF, State Programme Unit (SPU) at State/UT level, and District Programme Unit (DPU) at district level including necessary institutional arrangements/structure at the sub-district level.
- 3. In pursuance of the aforementioned provisions, detailed Guidelines on Administrative Expenses under the 'Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) have been formulated and enclosed herewith.

4. It is requested that the State Governments/UT Administrations may please utilize the Guidelines for availing the required administrate expenses benefits of the PMMSY.

Guidelines and Cost Norms for ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY)

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) provides that 2.5% of the annual budgetary allocation under PMMSY (central share) would be earmarked for meeting the administrative expenses for implementation, monitoring, evaluation and review of PMMSY (both Central Sector and Centrally Sponsored Scheme components) by the Department of Fisheries (DoF), National fisheries Development Board(NFDB) and the End Implementing Agencies (EIAs). Additionally, PMMSY provides that DoF, on the recommendation of the Central Apex Committee (CAC) of PMMSY, will earmark the extent of funds under administrative expenses that would be released to NFDB & EIAs.
- 1.2 PMMSY provides that DoF would be the competent authority to decide the modalities and guidelines including cost norms for incurring expenditure under Administrative expenses. This also includes the modalities, guidelines and cost norms for establishing and operating the Project Appraisal Committee (PAC) and Programme Monitoring Unit (PMU) in NFDB; the Central Standing Committee(CSC), Central Apex Committee(CAC) and Project Monitoring and Evaluation Unit (PMEU) in DoF; the State Programme Unit (SPU) at State/UT level, and District Programme Unit (DPU) at district level including necessary institutional arrangements/structure at the sub-district level.

2. BROAD ADMISSIBLE ACTIVITIES

- 2.1 Hiring of minimum manpower for CSC, CAC and PMEU in DoF, PAC and PMU in NFDB, SPU at State/UT level, DPU at district level and need based institutional arrangements/structures at the sub-district level including office expenses, allowances etc.
- 2.2 Procuring minimum infrastructure like furniture/fixtures, computers/laptops, printers, software etc. for establishment, operationalization and day-to-day functioning of the institutional arrangements/structures mentioned at 2.1 above.
- 2.3 Any other need-based support/services to the institutional arrangements/structures mentioned at 2.1 above as decided by DoF

- 2.4 Information Education Communication (IEC) activities and preparation of IEC material including electronic and print materials.
- 2.5 Preparation of required MIS along with necessary hardware/software and its operation.
- 2.6 Design, development and operation of online PMMSY portal in DoF.
- 2.7 Publicity and promotional activities for PMMSY through electronic, social and print media.
- 2.8 Hiring of Project/Programme Management Consultants /Advisory (PMC/PMA) and knowledge partners.
- 2.9 Organizing seminars, workshops, meets, summits/conferences (regional, national and International), official meetings, etc.
- 2.10 Organizing fish farmers and fisheries cooperative meets.
- 2.11 Evaluation of PMMSY.
- 2.12 Hiring of vehicles.
- 2.13 Design and printing of guidelines, publications, SOPs and other documents related to PMMSY, as necessary.
- 2.14 Periodic evaluation (mid-term) whenever required and post-implementation evaluation (end-term) of PMMSY through third party/ independent agency/individual domain experts.
- 2.15 Activities to support quality control and regulation of the fisheries sector aimed at enhancing quality, production and productivity.
- 2.16 Hiring/engagement of domain experts and support staff on contractual basis in DoF.
- 2.17 Preparation of 5 year prospective plan, Annual Plan and assisting the States/UTs for preparation of their fisheries vision documents, annual plans, District Fisheries Plans etc.
- 2.18 Organizing events such as Fish Farmers Day(FFD), World Fisheries Day or any other such event including awards and functions.

2.19 Any other activities as may be required for administration and smooth implementation of PMMSY.

3. FUNDING PATTERN

- 3.1 The sub-component of administrative expenses is covered under the Central Sector Scheme Component of PMMSY. The Central Sector Component of PMMSY provides 100% central financial assistance for the activities envisaged under the CS Component.
- 3.2 The entire cost of admissible activities mentioned in Para-2 with the ceiling specified in Para-5will be borne by the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Gol.
- 3.3 The End Implementing Agencies will be entitled to get 100% central funding support for taking up the activities mentioned in the Para-2 above and as detailed at para-5.

4. END IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES (EIAs)

- 4.1 The Activities mentioned in Para-2 above will be implemented through the following agencies:
 - (i) Central Government and its entities including National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB)
 - (ii) State/UT Governments and their entities
 - (iii) State Fisheries Development Boards
 - (iv) Any other End Implementing Agencies as decided by Department of Fisheries

5. QUANTUM OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

5.1 The details of admissible financial assistance and corresponding ceiling pertaining to each activity under the administrative expenses of PMMSY are furnished in the table below:
