

Assistant Research Officer (Fisheries) with three years' of regular service in Level- 7 of Pay Matrix (44900-142400)

Note 1: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite or qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service, or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Note 2: For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1.1.2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th CPC recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of Pay Commission.

Deputation (Including Short-Term Contract):

Officers of the Central or State or UT Administration or Autonomous bodies or Recognised Research Institute or Universities or Statutory Bodies:-

- (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or Department; or
with two years' service in the grade rendered after appointment there to on regular basis in Level 08 of Pay Matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; or,
with three years' service in the grade rendered after appointment there to on regular basis in level 07 of Pay Matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and,
(b) Possessing the educational qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits under column (7).

Note 1: The Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organisation/Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment on deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of the receipt of application.)

Note 2: For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on regular basis by an officer prior to 1.1.2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th CPC recommended has been extended; shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendation of the Pay Commission except where there has been the merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the posts for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.
