For the time being, the other five members will be outsourced through hiring process.

- 3. The Terms of Reference for the IT& e-Governance Cell is as below:
- a) Conceptualize IT projects for creation of effective IT systems for Department of Fisheries.
- b) Providing assistance for Procurement related –

- i. Study & documentation of Current state (As-Is)
- ii. Gap analysis and Best practices study
- iii. Future state (To-be) definition
- iv. Defining Solution architecture for to-be system
- v. Prepare DPR, RFP etc
- vi. Managing bid process, vendor on-boarding etc.
- d) Providing assistance for Implementation related
 - i. Establish a framework for reliable and accurate monitoring of the IT Service Providers performance and service delivery
 - ii. Monitoring of deliverables, timelines, and other tasks as agreed upon in contract
 - iii. Review project documents such as SRS, FRS, Solution Design, etc submitted by the Service providers.
 - iv. Development of Mobile apps, futuristic analytical dashboards.
 - v. Track the progress on the proposed and under-implementation change requests

- vi. Support UAT based on the test scripts provided by the Service providers.
- vii. Monitor the implementation of enhancements & adherence to the applicable e-Governance Standards
- viii. Provide inputs for the SLA measurement methodology and tool
- ix. Facilitate and monitor all upgrades/ replacement to solution components, including infrastructure
- x. Escalate the issues and monitor resolution thereof as may be appropriate
- xi. Provide periodic reports
- xii. Bring synergies across the service provider(s) as well as the various DoF institutions- Act as an intermediator between the DoF and service providers, Facilitate the exchange of data and information as and when required
- xiii. Support in the preparation of High-Level Design- The IT & e-Governance Cell shall work with the Service providers (s) to prepare and finalize the High-level design, application architecture etc
- 4. The IT & e- Governance cell will have IT & e- Governance work, Data Cell and Data & Strategy Unit (DSU).
- 5. The attempt is to be made for making the IT & e-Governance cell towards a permanent cell in the Department of Fisheries.
