In recognition of the contribution of Prof. C. R. Rao to Statistics, a renowned statistician for his outstanding contribution and distinguished service to the cause of Statistics and its application to the allied fields to Statistics, the Government of India has instituted a National Award in Statistics in his honour for **Young Statisticians for their significant contribution in the field of Statistics.** 

2. Nominations are invited online for **Prof. C. R. Rao National Award in Statistics 2024-25** at the National Awards Portal i.e., <a href="https://www.awards.gov.in">https://www.awards.gov.in</a> from 1<sup>st</sup> **January 2025**. The last date for the receipt of applications/nominations is 28<sup>th</sup> **February, 2025**. Details about the award and eligibility criteria are as under:

#### i. The Award:

- **a.** Prof. C.R. Rao National Award in Statistics carries a cash prize of Rs. 5.0 Lakh (Rupees Five Lakhs) only along with a citation, shawl and memento.
- **b.** Expenditure on travel by Air (by shortest route), as admissible to Joint Secretary level officers of the Government of India, to the venue of the award presentation ceremony and boarding and lodging is also provided to the awardee for participating in the award presentation ceremony.

## ii. Eligibility Criteria:

The eligibility for the award is as under:

- **a.** All Indian Nationals without distinction of race, occupation, position and gender are eligible for the award.
- **b.** The applicant should be less than 45 years of age as on 31<sup>st</sup> December of the financial year in which award is announced.
- c. Any official and/or his/her family member(s), who was/were part of the selection process of the awardees, will be out of consideration zone of the awards.

### iii. Submission of applications/nominations:

- a. The eligible candidates can nominate themselves or the names can also be proposed by institutions. The nomination/application should be supported by three distinguished statisticians/referees.
- b. Applications for Prof. C. R. Rao National Award in Statistics 2024-25 along with the testimonials of three distinguished statisticians/referees are invited through the National Awards Portal of Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) only at <a href="https://www.awards.gov.in">https://www.awards.gov.in</a>
- c. Posthumous Cases: If the person proposed to be honoured, has passed away recently (say within a year), the award may be given posthumously.

#### iv. Procedure for selection of awardee:

- a. The selection of awardee(s) will be done in four stages, as below:
  - Primary Scrutiny by Subject Matter Division of MoSPI.
  - Examination by Screening Committee
  - External Scrutiny Examination
  - Final Selection of the Nominee by Award Committee
- **b. Approving Authority:** Hon'ble Minister of Statistics & Programme Implementation

## v. Presentation of Award:

**a.** The Award will be presented during Statistics Day function on 29th June 2025. At this ceremony, citations highlighting the work of the awardee would be read out and awardee may also be requested to take a session highlighting significance of their work.
