Goa – State Level Fisheries Schemes (2025–26)

Overview

1. **State Fisheries Budget (2025–26):** ₹93.63 crore
2. **Fishermen Benefited (01 Apr–30 Nov 2025):** ~893
3. **Staff Strength:** 158 regular staff + 28 Sagar Mitras

Schemes and Activities

1. Marine Fisheries: Craft, Gear & Fuel Support

- **Fishing Craft (Construction/purchase of Wooden / FRP Canoes):** 50% subsidy up to ₹60,000 (Gen) / ₹80,000 (SC/ST)
- **Fishing Gear & Nets (Gill / River Gill Nets):** 50% subsidy up to ₹30,000–₹40,000
- **Inland Water Fishing Craft (<26 ft):** 50–60% subsidy up to ₹36,000
- **Barrier Nets:** 50–60% subsidy up to ₹36,000

2. Safety & Basic Infrastructure

- **Life Jackets & Lifebuoys:** 100% support (₹1,000 per life jacket; ₹1,500 per lifebuoy)
- **Insulated Fish Boxes (50L–400L):** 75% subsidy up to ₹11,000
- **Grant-in-aid to Fishermen Cooperative Societies:** ₹50,000 per society

3. Aquaculture & Mariculture Development

- **Brackish water Aquaculture Farms:** 25% subsidy on construction & feed; 50% on equipment

- **Mussel & Oyster Farming (Estuarine / Open Sea):** 50% subsidy up to ₹25,000–₹40,000
- **Crab Farming Units:** 25%–50% subsidy up to ₹1.5 lakh per ha
- **Freshwater Aquaculture Farms:** 25% subsidy on construction/feed; 50% on equipment
- **Ornamental Fish Breeding & Rearing Units:** 50% subsidy up to ₹2.5 lakh

4. Value Addition, Credit & Welfare

- **Seafood Value Addition Units:** 50% subsidy (₹5 lakh for civil works; ₹2 lakh for equipment)
- **Interest Subsidy on Fisheries Loans:** 4% (short-term) and up to 8% (long-term) interest subsidy
- **Natural Calamity Relief to Fishermen:** Compensation for damage/loss of craft and gear
- **Mukhyamantri Nustekar Mazat Yevjan:** Lump sum assistance up to ₹50,000 to next of kin
- **Fish Vendor Support (Vending Accessories):** 50–60% subsidy up to ₹12,000

Goa – State Level Fisheries Schemes (2025–26)

Goa – Petrol Subsidy for OBM-Operated Fishing Canoes

Scheme Description

- Operational support scheme for traditional and small-scale marine fishermen
- Applicable to fishing canoes fitted with Outboard Motors (OBM)

Financial Assistance

- Subsidy rate: ₹30 per litre of petrol
- Admissible quantity:
 - Up to 1,000 litres/year
 - Up to 1,100 litres/year for SC/ST fishermen

Eligibility & Implementation

- Registered fishermen
- Fishing craft operating with OBM
- Implemented through Fisheries Department mechanisms

Coverage

- 705 beneficiaries (highest among all Goa schemes)

Key features

- Dominant scheme in terms of beneficiary coverage
- Purely operational cost support (no asset creation)
